2008 PROJECT OF THE YEAR AWARD GUIDELINES

Purpose: To recognize outstanding achievement and innovation for repairing concrete.

Criteria

1. Major portion of the project must be a concrete repair.
2. Project must be within the state of Georgia.
3. Concrete portion of the project must be performed and completed by a Georgia Chapter of record during the year that the project was performed and during the year of submittal (2007 and 2008). Project must be substantially complete at time of submission.
4. Project submitted for consideration must be completed no earlier than the calendar year preceding the year of the Award (2007).
5. Project submittals can be made by any GA ICRI member on any size concrete repair project.

Submittal Process

1. Project solicitation will be by this form that has been mailed or faxed.
2. **Entry Fee of \$95.00 per Category**
3. Submittals shall be in the form of a 3 ring loose leaf notebook containing the required submittal data and no more than 12 pictures of any size (within the notebook).
4. Project submittals shall be addressed and forwarded to **GA ICRI Project Awards Committee, c/o Matt Lawler, Building Restoration Products, 5060 Old Ellis Pointe, Suite 100, Roswell, GA 30076 post marked or received no later than November 16, 2008.**

Required Submittal Data

1. The name of the project.
2. The address where the project was located.
3. The names of the concrete repair contractor, Owner, Architect, General Contractor and Design Engineer/Architect.
4. The contract price of the concrete repair portion of the project.
5. The project duration and the concrete repair duration.
6. A written summary not exceeding 1000 words summarizing the concrete repair.
7. A written statement not exceeding 300 words stating the significance of the concrete repair to the overall project purpose.

Review Process

The Board of Directors will review and judge each project submittal and select the project judged the best submitted for the award.

Award and Project Presentation

1. The award will be presented to the Concrete Repair Contracting Company, major Material Supplier, Architect/Engineer and Owner which has the highest submittal rating.
2. The Concrete Repair Contracting Company award winner's name will be presented on a banner at each Chapter function during the calendar year following the award.
3. The project award winner will be contacted before December 1, 2008.
4. The project is to be presented in a 15 to 20 minute presentation by one of the project members during the December Holiday dinner meeting.
